






## Revenue, Expense, Census & Sessions Trends: July 2023 – June 2024


**Revenue:** The Revenue decreased by 27% from the previous Fiscal Year.




**Expense:** The expenses increased by 56% during this period.

Sessions: LaurelCare had a 46% growth in average monthly sessions during this period.






